3a. Consider Motion to Approve Final Concept Design, Art In Private Development Public Art Project, Museum Square – Kevin Vaughan-Brubaker, Public Art Manager

Board Members have asked for additional information and design details from the artist and decided to table the vote until the next board meeting.

3b. Consider Motion to Approve Artist Finalists, Scottsdale Waterfront Splash Pad Public Art Project – Tanya Galin, Public Art Coordinator

Tanya Galin, public art coordinator presented the final artists selected for the Scottsdale Waterfront Splash Pad public art project. Annette Coleman; Dominic Panziera and Daniela Garofalo; and Rachel Rodi have been selected to move forward with interviews prior to final artist selection for the project.

A motion was made by Jaime Neufer and seconded by Carter Unger to approve Annette Coleman; Dominic Panziera and Daniela Garofalo; and Rachel Rodi as finalists for the Scottsdale Waterfront splash pad public art project.
