**3a.** Civic Center Renovations and Public Art – Kim Boganey, Scottsdale Public Art Director

City of Scottsdale staff and the renovation design team presented a brief overview of the Scottsdale Civic Center renovation project, and locations for the sculptures impacted by the renovations. **4a.** Consider Motion to Approve Concept Design, Waterfront Splash Pad Public Art – Tanya Galin, Public Art Coordinator

Tanya Galin provided a brief overview of the Scottsdale Waterfront Splash Pad public art project. Annette Coleman, the selected artist for the project, presented her concept design. A discussion amongst board members ensued. There were questions regarding the design of the artwork. The artist provided further detail regarding the decision to move forward with the current design. Board members provided feedback for the artist to consider.

A motion was made by Christine Kovach, and seconded by Miho Mizukami-Schettker, to approve the concept design for the Scottsdale Waterfront Splash Pad public art project. The motion passed with 13 yea votes and 1 no vote.

**4b.** Consider Motion to Approve Donation into the Portable Works Collection the Following Artwork: Lex Gjurasic, *Portrait of Nola, But Like Also a Flower Mound*, 2021, mixed media on paper, 25.5 x 18 inches - Wendy Raisanen, Curator of Collections and Exhibitions

Wendy Raisanen provided a brief presentation of the donation *Portrait of Nola, But Like Also a Flower Mound* by Lex Gjurasic.

A motion was made by Jaime Neufer, and seconded by Jeff Miller, to approve the donation into the Portable Works collection the following artwork: Lex Gjurasic, *Portrait of Nola, But Like Also a Flower Mound*, 2021, mixed media on paper, 25.5 x 18 inches. The motion passed unanimously.

**4c.** Consider Motion to Approve Renewal of Three-Year Term for Public Art Advisory Board Member Elan Mizrahi – Jaime Neufer, Vice Chair, Scottsdale Public Art Advisory Board

A motion was made by Jaime Neufer, and seconded by Christine Kovach, to approve the three-year term for Public Art Advisory Board Member Elan Mizrahi to the Scottsdale Public Art Advisory Board. The motion passed with 13 yea votes and 1 abstention.
